4. 2018-19 SLT Estimated Expenditures were reviewed by Bergeson

- Goal 1: Lower class size, Elective classes, Full time teachers Teacher Salaries and Employee Benefits (Reading 8th grade, Math Block 8th grade, Teachers in full time contracts, Extra class periods) \$74,000
  - Goal 2: Academic Interventions (Ewell, Lybyer)  
Teacher Salaries and Employee Benefits \$9,400
  - Goal 3: Academic Interventions (PAWS)  
Teacher Salaries and Employee Benefits \$8,465
- Total: \$91,865

Melissa Stirling asked how much we actually get. Bergeson responded that when budgets are put together, they usually estimate lower just to be safe. Usually they get a little more than the estimate.

Bergeson called for a vote to approve the estimated budget. The vote was 100% in favor of the current estimate.
