2. 2018-19 SLT Estimated Expenditures:

Steve passed info and we read over parent responsibilities and the checklist for a school community council office.

- Goal 1: Lower class size, Elective classes, Full time teachers Teacher Salaries and Employee Benefits (Reading 8th grade, Math Block 8th grade, Teachers in full time contracts, Extra class periods) \$74,000
 - Goal 2: Academic Interventions (Ewell, Lybyer) Teacher Salaries and Employee Benefits \$9,400
 - Goal 3: Academic Interventions (PAWS) Teacher Salaries and Employee Benefits \$8,465
- Total: \$91,865
