Review Minutes from October Meeting: Elissa Liddle

Business Items:

- **Student Use of School Technology Issues**
 - Proposed Changes: Worked on Jan. 3rd for an allowed list. Trying to balance blocking everything versus an “allowed list”.
 - Teacher Feedback: Teachers have been proactive and willing to work with school. Some frustrations. Is it a students’ account vs a certain chromebook. Teachers are projecting up students’ screens the front board. Teachers have great sense of responsibility and it’s being pushed.
 - Parent Feedback: Helping students to feel safe
 - Student Feedback: Relieved and more aware
 - Status on change implementation or what is the timeline? Continue to make it as functional as possible, how impero is working to address issues? Parent meeting Jan. 15th for 2020-21 registration could also address tech. Internet safety tip on parent email and school website.
 - Is additional funding needed to support changes? Working within existing resources (Follow up in Feb.)
 - Possible survey to assess needs of teachers/students: Teachers are supportive. Students are not.
 - Review District Policy regarding/expectations. How does PVMS measure up? PVMS is owning their own changes and are in line.
 - How is Digital Citizenship taught to students and parents? Is PVMS using the 8 modules offered by the district? (Digital Respon-A-bility/Prevent Child Abuse Utah) PVMS Digital Lit is taught in all 8th grade classes. Possible parent night.

- **Wellness Room**
 - How many students are accessing this resource per day? 3-4 per day. Since opening, there have been about 200 responses.
 - Are teachers allowing students to leave or are they trying to “talk them out of going”? Teachers are encouraging and do allow to go.
 - How do students perceive the wellness room? Many are doing well with it. It will take time to work through it. Any type of survey been given? Issue a simple survey during registration.

- **School Safety**

- Update on District retrofit for security/lockdown doors: Architects and engineers have been here. Have not been out since. Perimeter is locked down within 10-15 minutes after school.
- Fire/Lockdown drills
 - § Are parents aware of procedures? Drill is required monthly.
- High traffic at 130 North intersection
 - § Low visibility of pedestrians when exiting the school
 - § Possible to move the crosswalk further down 2145 East? No allowed. Panorama has adjusted time to try to control ped traffic.
 - § Share cost of crossing guard with Panorama Elementary School? Does not feel necessary right now.
