Minutes: Review Minutes from March 5th Meeting: Elissa Liddle

- Carrie moved to approve the minutes from January and the March agenda, Cindy seconded the motion.

Business Items:

1. Review final 2019-20 school plan expenses
 - Funded 3 full time teachers out of the Trust Land Budget \$95,975. Budgeted for \$96,000.
 - Had carryover of \$166.

2. Review 2020-21 school plan submitted and identify data that will be used to track the plan's success.
 - \$97,479 Budgeted for teacher salary, lower class sizes, interventions.
 - Funded \$98, 562. Carry over of \$1844
 - Utah only sustained 2% budget cut. Utah did very well compared to other states.
 - Applied for tech grant for \$40,000 for the next five years. Ordering 120 new chrome books and 3 new carts. Will not need to come from trust land. Chrome books are touch screen and will go to the math department. In the process of being ordered.
 - Trust land budget in the past has been used for teachers, class sized and intervention. Christy Coleman is a district contact.
 - Thoughts on what to spend the budget on? Can only be spent on direct instruction for kids. Carrie suggested keeping class sizes down and teachers.
 - Cindy asked about after school programs. Covid has influenced the opportunities. Robotics. Science Olympiads, Math Counts, Athletics.

- TSSA funding has been increased to \$112,000. Funding the following: LCSW is here once a week, jazz band, science teacher, another teacher, and stipends for more intervention, music accompanist, science stipends, wellness room salary, put sound systems in 25 classrooms, teacher training.
 - Possibly spending more money on face shields
