- STL Budget 2023-2024 Review/update
 - i) 55% in RISE and ASPIRE testing in core subject
 - ii) Action plan- Hire a full time History teacher, an extra Geography class period, and an extra PE period to reduce the class sizes of the core classes. Salaries and Benefits estimated \$102,995.00
