The meeting was called to order by Principal Brett Gifford, who welcomed attendees and introduced the agenda.

Agenda Items:

Technology Spending:

The council discussed how to allocate \$18,000 earmarked for technology spending. Currently, all classrooms are 1:1 for Chromebooks, funded by a technology grant. Several ideas for additional technology were proposed, including:

- Makerspace items for the library
- Green screens and videography equipment for the media center (to be updated following the new boundary changes)
- iPads and iPhones for film courses
- Virtual reality (VR) headsets for geography education

Mr. Gifford will collect a wishlist from teachers to determine their technology needs and how they plan to use the requested items. This list will be reviewed at the next meeting to make final decisions.

Data Overview:

The council reviewed Pine View Middle School's data and discussed goals for the next academic year.

Panther Family Night:

Feedback was shared regarding Panther Family Night, which was successful overall. Advertising will be adjusted next year to emphasize that the event is free. Suggestions included holding separate events at Fossil, Pine View Middle, and the high school in the future.

School Board and Boundary Update:

Current enrollment stands at 703 students, with 698 projected for next year.

Other Items:

Updates on clubs and academic teams returning to the middle school level were discussed. The high school recently held a club rush event to engage students. Plans for the science fair were confirmed, with discussions about potentially introducing a Science Olympiad in the future.

Other ideas included adding a gaming club, pickleball courts or tournaments, and exploring new activities for students.

It was noted that the school no longer has a greenhouse.

Next Meeting:

The next Community Council meeting will be held on Tuesday, December 10, 2024, at 2:00 PM in the Pine View Middle School counseling office.

The meeting concluded with no further business.
